



## Travelling to La Grave

La Grave is situated in the Hautes Alpes region of France on the Route National 91, between Grenoble and Briançon.

### Arrival by car

From Grenoble take the RN91 direction Briançon and Gap. Grenoble to La Grave is 77 km and takes approximately 1.5 hours. The Hotel Edelweiss is situated back from the road on the left-hand side, as you drive up (heading East) through the village. There is a car park on the right-hand side of the road, near the tourist office. Access to the hotel is by walking up the steps between the Mairie and the Gendarmarie.

The hotel has a charging point for electric cars.

Ignore any GPS directions via the Col du Galibier. This is a high mountain pass, which is closed from late November to May.

The road from Turin to La Grave goes over two high mountain cols that are subject to close in windy and snowy weather.

### Arrival by train

Grenoble train station is serviced by the French TGV (fast train) from Paris (3 hours) and the high-speed Eurostar from London (7 hours). Grenoble station has frequent connections with all major French towns.

It is possible to take the train from Grenoble to Briançon (and then take a taxi or bus to La Grave). Trains from Grenoble to Briançon leave every 2 hours, travelling via Gap. The journey takes approximately 4hrs. Details on the SNCF Website

### **Arrival by air**

Budget airlines fly from the UK to both Turin and Grenoble airports.

From Grenoble airport, you need to take a transfer bus into Grenoble, and then the LER 35 scheduled bus service to Briançon, Serre Chevalier and La Grave. The bus passes through La Grave 4 times a day. It takes 1.5 hours. Buy tickets online in advance.

Ben's Bus is a shared transfer service from Grenoble Airport to the Barrage du Chambon, connecting with most flights. From the Barrage du Chambon, you can book a taxi to get you to La Grave. On Saturdays, they also have a direct service from Grenoble Airport to La Grave.
