Flying to La Grave

Budget airlines fly from the UK to both Turin and Grenoble airports.

The Alpine Transfer Company run scheduled and shared transfers from Turin Airport to Serre Chevalier. From here it's possible to get a taxi to La Grave (see below). Groups can also book a private transfer onward to La Grave.

From Grenoble airport, you need to take a transfer bus into Grenoble, and then the LER 35 scheduled bus service to Briançon, Serre Chevalier and La Grave. There is one direct bus a day from Grenoble to La Grave. If you take one of the other buses, then you'll need to hire a taxi from Serre Chevalier to La Grave (see below).

Reservation is obligatory for the bus. Details can be found on the Transdev Dauphine Website Ticket prices have been reduced to 15 Euros to compensate for disruption caused by the road closure.

Getting the Train

It is possible to take the train from Grenoble to Briançon (and then take a taxi to La Grave). Trains from Grenoble to Briançon leave every 2 hours, travelling via Gap. The journey takes approximately 4hrs. Details on the SNCF Website
